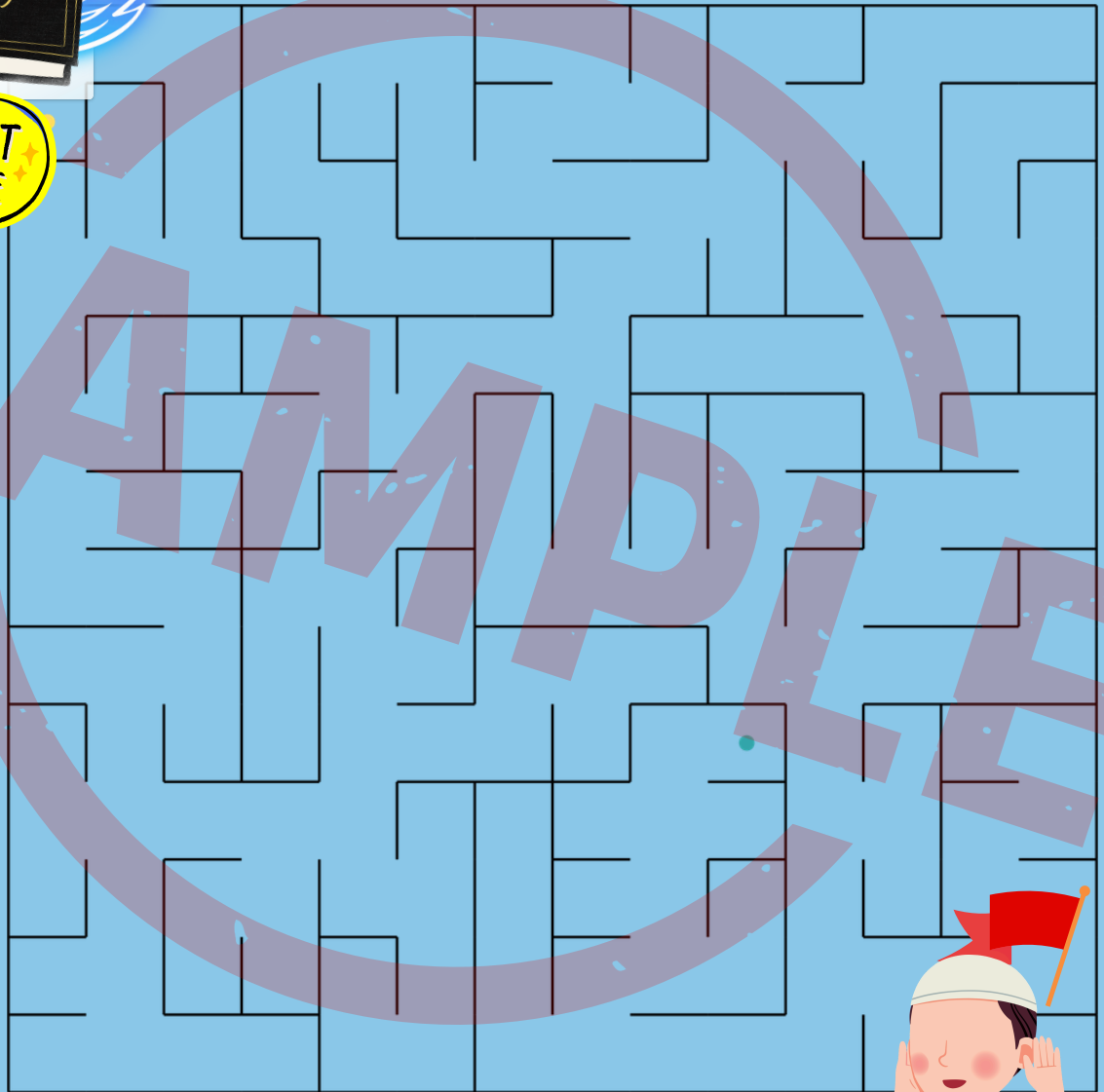

## The Protectors of the Qur'an – A Story of the Sahabah

A long time ago, when the Qur'an was being revealed to Prophet Muhammad ﷺ, there were no printing presses, no books, and no apps. So how did people keep the Qur'an safe?



The Prophet ﷺ would recite each new Ayah (verse) to the people as soon as he received it from Angel Jibreel (A.S). The Sahabah—the Prophet's special companions—loved the Qur'an so much that they would memorize it right away. They didn't just learn the words—they lived them.

Zayd ibn Thabit (R.A) was a young companion who became one of the main scribes. He listened carefully, wrote down the verses, and memorized them. So did Abu Bakr, Umar, Aisha, Ali, and many others (RadiAllahu Tala Anhum)—some memorized the entire Qur'an by heart!

## Plan to Move

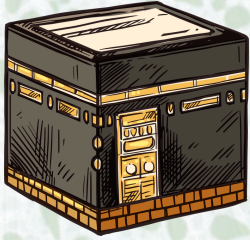

## Life in Madinah

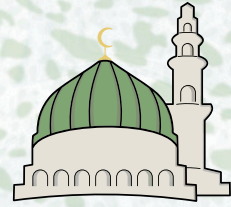

The Story of Prophet Yusuf (A.S.) — Trust, Patience, and Dreams  
In the blessed Qur'an, Allah revealed the entire story of Yusuf (A.S.) in Surah Yusuf, calling it "the best of stories" (Ahsan al-Qasas) (12:3). It is not just a story—it's a guide to patience, trust, and the mercy of Allah.

### 1. The Dream of a Prophet-to-Be

Yusuf (A.S.) was the beloved son of Prophet Yaqub (A.S.). One night, he came to his father with wonder in his heart and said:

"O my father! Indeed I have seen [in a dream] eleven stars and the sun and the moon; I saw them prostrating to me." (12:4)

Yaqub (A.S.), with the wisdom of a prophet, knew this dream was special. He warned Yusuf (A.S.) not to tell his brothers, for "Shaytaan is to man a clear enemy." (12:5)

### 2. Betrayed by His Brothers

Out of jealousy, Yusuf's brothers plotted against him. They convinced their father to let Yusuf (A.S.) accompany them, but their hearts were darkened by envy. They threw him into a deep well and lied to their father, pretending that a wolf had devoured him.

Yet Allah was with Yusuf. "And Allah is predominant over His affair, but most of the people do not know." (12:21)
